



Short & Snuggly Shrug

A quick to knit shrug in luxurious mohair and enhanced with a simple beaded ruffle

Skill Level - Beginner

Materials:

- King Cole Luxury Mohair [78% mohair, 13% wool, 9% nylon; 110 yards/50gms]; 2 balls "Roma 247" (any bulky weight mohair yarn will work as long as it is thin enough to accommodate the beads)
- US Size 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 11 circular needles, 16"
- 200 size 6 clear AB silver lined seed beads
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

Gauge:

Finished piece measures 29" x 11"

Notes:

Shrug is worked in two halves from the center out. The beads are added at the end for ease of knitting.

Abbreviations:

k - knit
kfb - knit into the front and back of the next stitch
s1b - slip one bead

Shrug:

1. Cast on 50 stitches.
2. Work in stockinette (knit right side rows and purl wrong side rows) until piece measures 8".
3. Place stitch marker and join to work in the round (knitting every row) for 5".
4. On next round, kfb around.
5. Knit one round even.
6. String on 100 beads from end of yarn.
7. Next round *p1, s1b* around.
8. Switch to larger needles and bind off in knit stitch.
9. At cast on edge use second ball of yarn to pick up 50 stitches and work second half of shrug the same as the first.
10. Weave in loose ends.
